Ten Steps to Successful Breastfeeding

Formulated by the World Health Organization & UNICEF

Every facility providing maternity services & care for newborn infants should:

- 1. Have a written breastfeeding policy that is routinely communicated to all health care staff.
- 2. Train all health care staff in skills necessary to implement this policy.
- 3. Inform all pregnant women about the benefits and management of breastfeeding.
- 4. Help mothers initiate breastfeeding within a half hour of birth.
- 5. Show mothers how to breastfeed, and how to maintain lactation even if they are separated from their infants.
- 6. Give newborn infants no food or drink other than breastmilk, unless medically indicated.
- 7. Practice rooming-in: allow mothers and infants to remain together 24 hours a day.
- 8. Encourage breastfeeding on demand.
- 9. Give no rubber nipples or pacifiers to breastfeeding infants.
- 10. Foster the establishment of breastfeeding support groups, and refer mothers to them on discharge from the hospital or clinic.
